

# The Girls Beauty Shop

We are now very close to your big day, and hope to provide some beauty tips to ensure a flawless and smooth day for you and your maids. Be sure to pay close attention to time frames and processes to provide you with the best results. This information should also be sent to anyone participating in the beauty services as well.

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## HAIR

- Be sure your hair has been washed within 2 - 3 days. We all know our hair best so please choose based on best results.
- Avoid letting your hair air-dry. This can cause frizz as well as eliminating volume. A good blow dry with a round brush and product is recommended. Hair must be COMPLETELY dried
- When styling your hair, refrain from straightening it if you wish to have a curly hairstyle. Doing so will cause your hair to be confused and can result in loss of curl or your hair refusing to curl.
- Refrain from placing your hair in a ponytail or bun of any kind. As we all know this can cause tangle and unwanted creases.
- Hair must be brushed and free from tangles
- Keep in mind your hair and how it response when you are choosing your style. If your hair does not hold a curl and you wish to have it down, we will do our best to have it hold, but we cannot make any promises. This goes for length and texture as well

## FACE

- All makeup must be removed before sitting in your artist chair. Pay close attention to eyeliner and mascara to ensure it is all removed.
- Contacts, teeth whitening, teeth brushing etc needs to be done well before your appointment time
- Resist doing any masks or treatments the week of the event date.
- Freshly manicured eyebrows are encouraged
- When choosing inspiration images, be sure to keep ethnicity, skin tone, eye shapes and colors etc in mind. We will do our best to accomplish your desired look while keeping your facial features in mind

## TIPS

- Having inspiration images for both hair and makeup are highly encouraged. Please save them to your camera roll for quick retrieval.
- Keep in mind, your artists are on a timeline so any preparation you can do to help eliminate smaller steps is greatly appreciated
